Winter Spotlight: Draft Horse Logging Camp

Have you always wanted to grow a beard and wear flannel? Do dreams of saws and axes fill your head? Come to the Knapp-Stout Logging Camp at Tomahawk's Snow Base and let your lumberjack dreams come to true! Stay in a Swedish dove-tailed cabin heated by wood stove. Learn what it was like to be a lumberjack in 1893 in the Northwoods of Wisconsin. Each Scout will limb a tree, and use a two-person saw to cut the tree into 16' sections.



Scouts will then take turns driving a team of draft horses as they pull their logs out of the woods, just like the Lumberjacks of old. When not out sawing logs, Scouts will get a chance to explore life as a lumberjack back at the main camp. Learn about the history of the Knapp Stout Logging Camp, while blacksmithing and making hearty Dutch oven meals. Adventure waits for you at the Knapp Stout Logging Camp, only at Snow Base.
